Depending on the Embassy or Int'l organization, it takes about 8 days to get the franchise. During this period, often demurrage and storage charges will occur.	<ul> <li>Used HHG's are NOT duty free in Equatorial Guinea for returning residents, returning diplomats and people coming to work in Equatorial Guinea except those working for companies that have a protocol agreement with the government in which an exemption of duties is clearly stipulated.</li> <li>Purchase invoices, clearly identifying electrical items, date year and place of purchase, are needed.</li> <li>The attendance of shipper is not required for import customs clearance</li> <li>TAXES</li> <li>None for diplomats</li> <li>10% on all used HHG based on the declared value as per valued inventory list.</li> <li>51.9% on new car</li> <li>38% on appliances</li> <li>50% for food (no tax if reasonable quantity)</li> <li>110 % for alcohol or tobacco (no tax if reasonable quantity)</li> </ul>
