Removal Goods	<ul> <li>Copy of valid passport.</li> <li>Original BILL OF Lading</li> <li>Original valued inventory list in French detailed, dated and signed by customer.</li> <li>Change of residence certificate.</li> <li>Bill of lading with price indicated for the freight.</li> </ul>	Tax on new goods may go up to 38.5% CIF value  Duties on cars 65% CIF value  Computers, printers, scanner are not considered as personal effects and are subject to duties and taxes (38.5% CIF value)  Even when duty free clearance is granted, customs levy a "RTL Tax" or 2% of CIF value, with a minimum of 300.000 GNF (approx 30 Euro). This applies to ALL shipments, even diplomatic.	Clearance: 7 days	
Diplomat's removals	<ul> <li>Exemption Certificate from Embassy or Consulate.</li> <li>Original French inventory, detailed, valorised, dated and signed by the owner.</li> </ul>	Duty free entry if the document for free entry is signed by the Foreign Ministry.  All documents must be provided to the DA Guinea at least 15 days before arrival of the shipment in order to apply and be granted duty free clearance prior to arrival of the shipment.  Even when duty free clearance is granted, customs levy a "RTL Tax" or 2% of CIF value, with a minimum of 300.000 GNF (approx 30 Euro). This applies to ALL shipments, even diplomatic.	For diplomatic air/sea shipments, origin agent must send as soon as possible all original documents to the destination agent. It takes at least 21 days to obtain the document for free entry from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and customs head office.	



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New Furniture and Household Goods	<ul> <li>Commercial invoice</li> <li>Packing list</li> <li>Copy of Ocean/Airway Bill of Lading</li> </ul>	Subject to customs duty and tax.	Clearance: 7 days.
Motor vehicles	<ul> <li>Original registration card</li> <li>Change of residence certificate</li> <li>Copy passport</li> <li>Copy purchase invoice for brand new vehicles</li> </ul>	Taxes on car will depend on age, power etc. (approx 65% CIF)	Second hand cars have to be controlled by "SGS" prior to importation.
Alcoholic beverages		Prohibited and should be sent separately. Only the mention "fond de cave" (less than 30 bottles) is acceptable.
