Precious metal objects		Duty free entry is allowed on the same basis and under the same conditions as furniture and other articles.	
Motor cars, motor cycles, mopeds	<ul> <li>Customs declaration.</li> <li>Document showing that the vehicle has been in the owner's use and possession abroad for 12 months and must provide proof of ownership and use by original purchase invoice, insurance certificate and maintenance invoices etc.</li> </ul>	Duty free entry if over 12 months old and the vehicles (cars, motor cycles, mopeds) will not be sold or otherwise disposed of for 15 months after the date of importation.	
Alcoholic beverages		Excise duty is based on C.I.F. value plus import duty. SPIRITS	Each person over 18 years is allowed duty free 1 litre only.
