T2L must be stamped at Customs from Origin country.  Alcohol forbidden

If not, deposit in favour of customs should be made. Such deposit shall be refundable after presence of ID card to Customs authorities (not later than 6 months after import).

<b>HOUSEHOLD GOODS</b>  <i>Returning Bulgarian Citizens</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Power of attorney legalized by a Bulgarian notary.</li> <li>Copy of "lichna karta"</li> <li>Declaration for the value of the goods / car legalized by a Bulgarian notary.</li> <li>Pro-forma invoice including INCO delivery</li> </ul>	Duty free entry only at Customs adjacent to residence registration as per "lichna karta"  There should not be a discrepancy of more than 12 months between date of arrival in Bulgaria and date of shipment arrival.	FORBIDDEN <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>alcohol</li> <li>tobacco</li> </ul> Several shipments are allowed, within 12 months period, following the date of return, only

<b>POV's</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Full documentation of vehicle such as registration certificate, title of vehicle, invoice of purchase.</li> </ul>	<p>Police statement that POV will be registered before clearance.</p> <p>Homologation certificate.</p> <p>POV is cleared only at specific Customs offices and this creates a problem for the household goods loaded in the same container.</p> <p>Normally transit clearance requires additional financial coverage of the Customs transit operation.</p>	
<b>PETS Incoming</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Valid Passport</li> <li>Dog must be at least 4 months old</li> <li>Must have rabies vaccination not over 6 months</li> <li>Identification Chip</li> <li>Veterinary/Health certificate</li> </ul>		
<b>Wood packaging</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Bulgaria adopted ISPM 15 to standardize the treatment of wood used for transport of goods.</li> </ul>		
<b>NOTA BENE</b>	<p>There is always the possibility that Import duty, VAT and excise be applied for import of HHG and cars and this is subject at cost.</p> <p>Customs orders if import duty, VAT and excise must apply based on the available documents, packing list, value declaration and period and reason of stay abroad. Final decision is upon Customs Chief. In most cases a tax of 5-20% and VAT 20% applies.</p> <p>Decision for duty free import is at Customs discretion. Orbit ltd. cannot be hold responsible for otherwise decision and amounts due to Customs !</p>
